

EBSCOHOST

Students and staff have access to a selection of electronic books on subjects such as animation, audio engineering, film and graphic design through EBSCOhost.

Access:

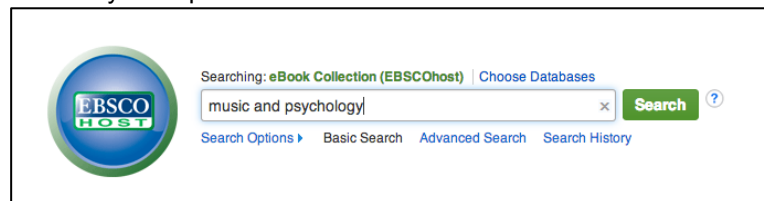
- Open a web browser and follow the link to databases from the library portal <http://library.saeaustralia.edu.au/>
- You will be logged in automatically on campus.
- If you are not on campus you will be prompted to login using your:

Username: Student Number or Student Portal (Axis) Username
Password: Day and month of birth in the format ddmm (10th Feb = 1002)

Searching:

Basic Search

- Type in keywords to describe your topic



Advanced Search

- You can narrow the search by selecting search mode and limiting your results to field such as Author, Date or Title. Tick 'Also search within the full text of the articles' to search for your terms within the book (this will retrieve more search results).

Displaying books:

- The results of a search will be displayed in a list.
- This list can be sorted in a particular order if desired.
- Preview the **table of contents** which links to particular chapters and view the **most relevant pages of the books**.


Select the link of the title to view the book

- Use your web browser or pdf viewer to copy or print selections of eBooks.
- You can print 15 pages per title per hour if you are logged in, and 10 pages per title per hour if you are not logged in.
- Copyright laws protect these books. Excessive usage is monitored and warnings provided.

For additional features:

- To set up a free account, you will have to login on campus the first time. Once logged in, click on 'Sign in' on the top right of the screen.

Through your account you can:

- Download eBooks for viewing offline. 
- Software requirements: Adobe Digital Editions.

- The checkout period can be from 24 hours to 1 week. Others cannot access the contents of an eBook while it is checked out or being read online.
